

FAQs

Q: Is my donation to Give Nebraska tax deductible?

A: Yes, Give Nebraska is a nonprofit 501(c) (3) organization, as are all of its member agencies. Gifts are tax deductible to the extent allowed by law.

Q: Why are there so many choices?

A: Give Nebraska's strength is in donor choice. No single federation could possibly fundraise for all nonprofit choices in our community. Our organization was formed in 1981 in response to donors asking for more and different choices and to nonprofits looking for new sources of funding.

Q: How does Give Nebraska evaluate the member agencies?

A: Give Nebraska evaluates the member agencies in two ways: Agencies must provide updated financial and program information annually; and they must participate in the running of Give Nebraska. It is a community-driven fund and we expect all agencies to participate.

Q: Why give through Give Nebraska instead of directly to the agency?

A: Give Nebraska does not want to discourage a donor from giving directly to agencies. Giving through Give Nebraska is another way, and perhaps a better way, for you to support your community. You can donate to multiple organizations through one gift. You can set up recurring gifts on our website to increase your impact.

Small gifts over time really add up! If your employer supports it, payroll deduction can be an even more effective way to give.
